CRYSTAL LAKE INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE PARADE MARSHAL RULES

Upon arrival at 11:00 a.m.

- DO NOT PARK IN THE BOSS OR MUNICIPAL BLGD PARKING LOTS-NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Park across the street from the Boss Bldg (110 Woodstock Street) or at the Train Station lot. (Walkup)
- Check in at the Municipal Lot
- Get to know the grounds
 - Port-a-Potties
 - Water
 - Garbage cans
 - Where your units are located

During Staging:

- Introduce yourself to your units.
- Let your units know that if they have any problems to come to you.
- Let them know where the water and port-a-potties are located.
- Explain to your units that they need to stay out of the lanes of traffic and children need to stay near their group.
- Go through the parade rules with your units.
- Stay with your units. Do not let them move to a different area unless they have been told to do so by a lot coordinator.
- Safety is our #1 concern!
- Stay with your unit until all take off at beginning of parade. Stay with your unit until all reach disbanding point.(South Elementary)

During Parade:

Make sure your units are following the rules:

- 1. No throwing of candy from vehicles or center of the street. Candy can be passed out or tossed gently from the curb.
- 2. No alcohol consumed or carried.
- 3. No water squirt guns, super soakers, hoses, ice, etc. If you see any spectators being especially vicious with water, inform the next police officer.
- 4. No passing out of literature or paper flyers. Candy and other give-aways allowed.
- 5. If a unit is not following the rules, firmly remind them of the rules and give them a warning. If it continues, have the next police officer escort them out of the parade. Remember this is a last resort for safety reasons.
- 6. Move back and forth between your units during the parade to make sure that they are all keeping up.
- 7. Escort your units all the way to the end of the parade. They will disband in the parking lot of South Elementary NOT in the street. A police officer will guide them at the end of route.
- 8. Use your cell phone to alert any health related concerns to a local police officer or dial *911 on your cell phone. Sharon Repplinger –Parade Coordinator cell phone 847-341-4514.
